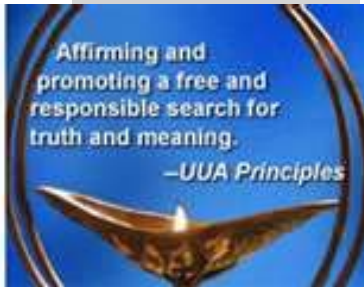

JOYS, SORROWS & CONCERNS

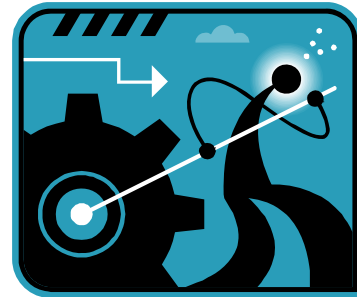
